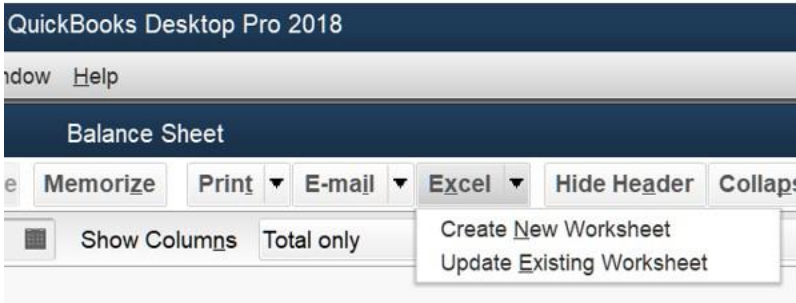


PROBLEM: Getting this message when trying to export a report to Excel:

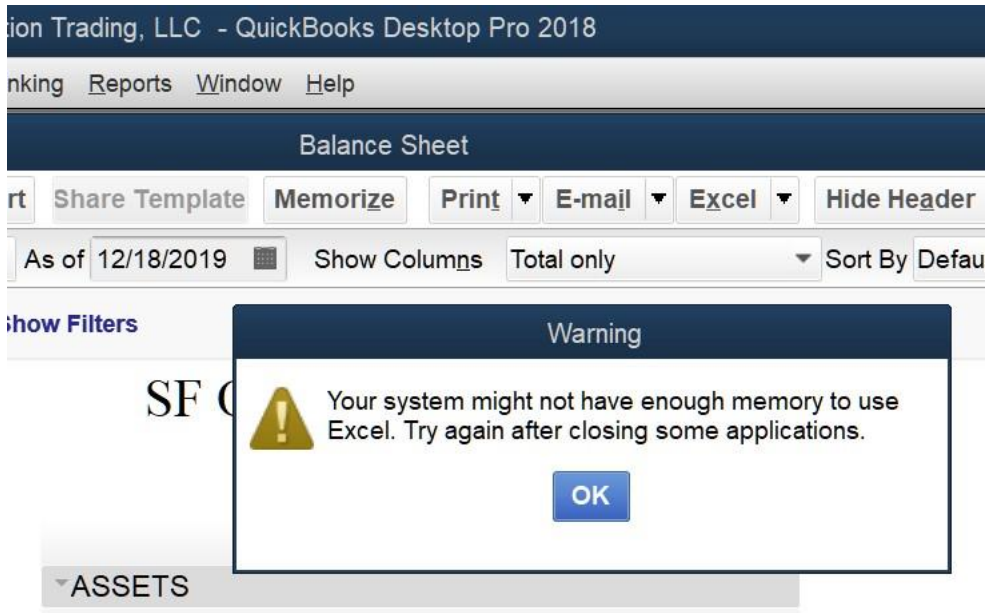
"Your system might not have enough memory to use Excel."

EXAMPLE:

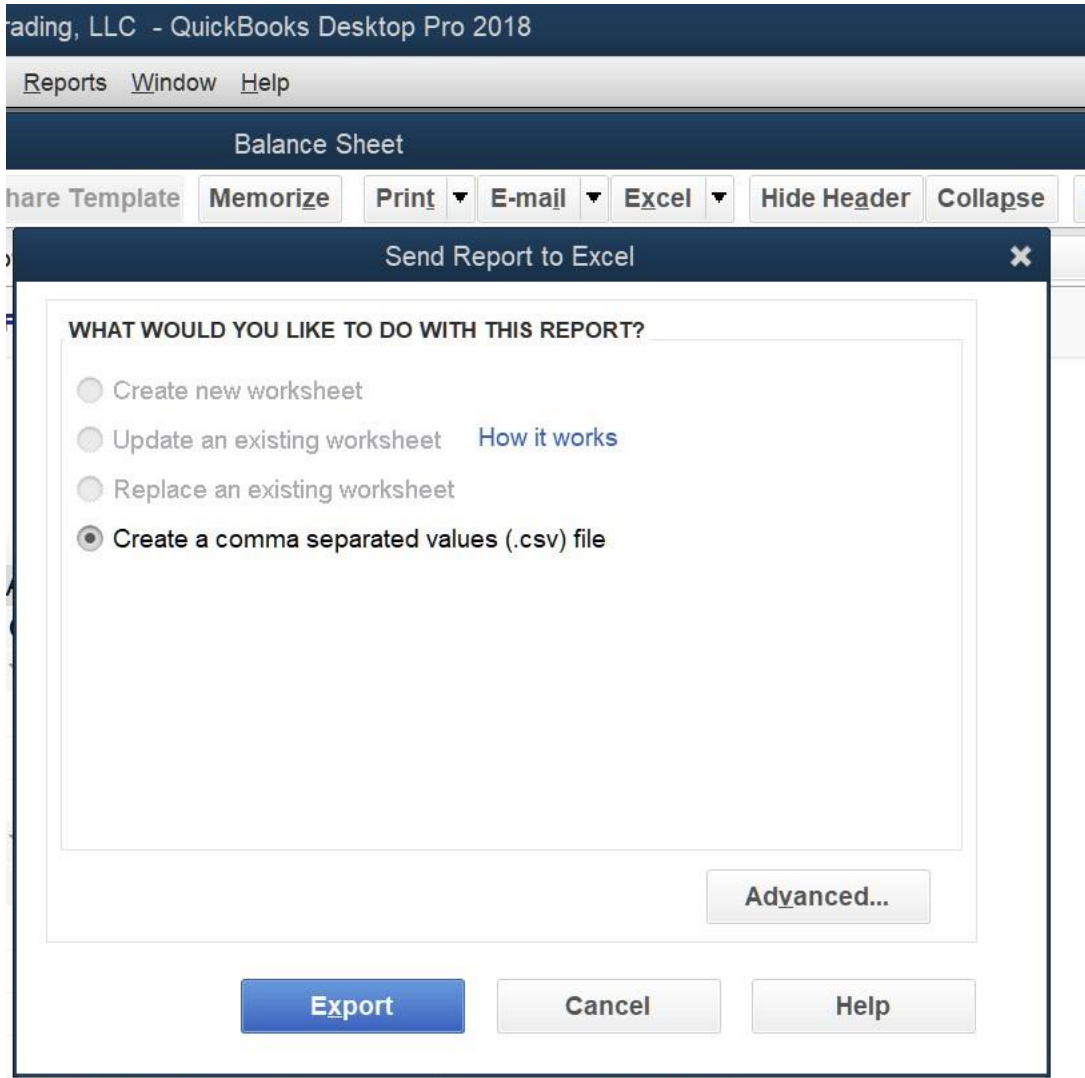
1. Click on Excel
2. Click on "Create New Worksheet".



3. Receive Warning message.

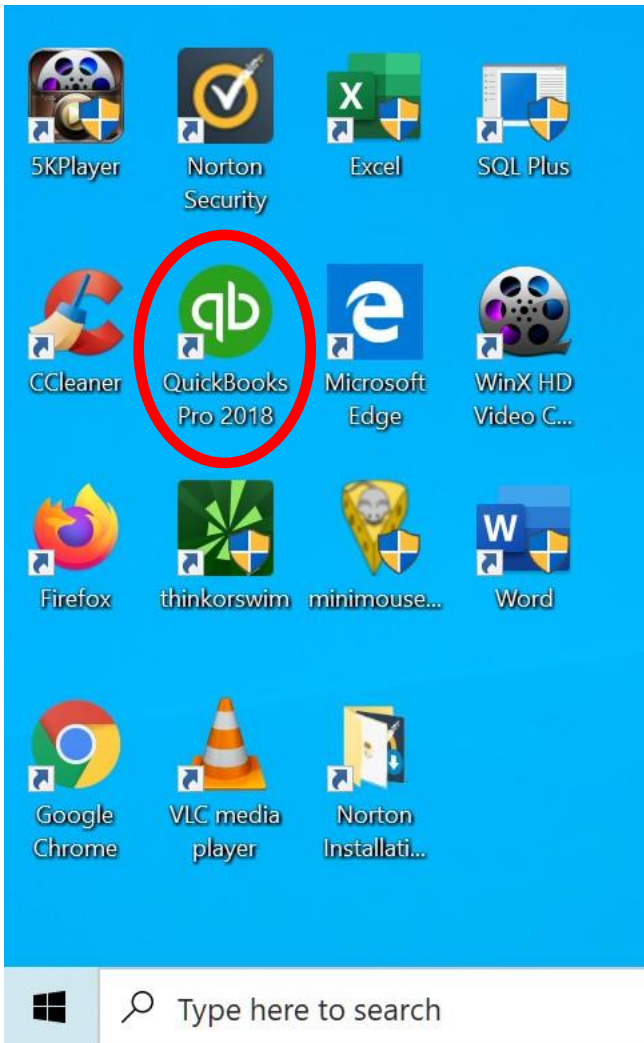


4. Quickbooks will, however, still allow a csv export:

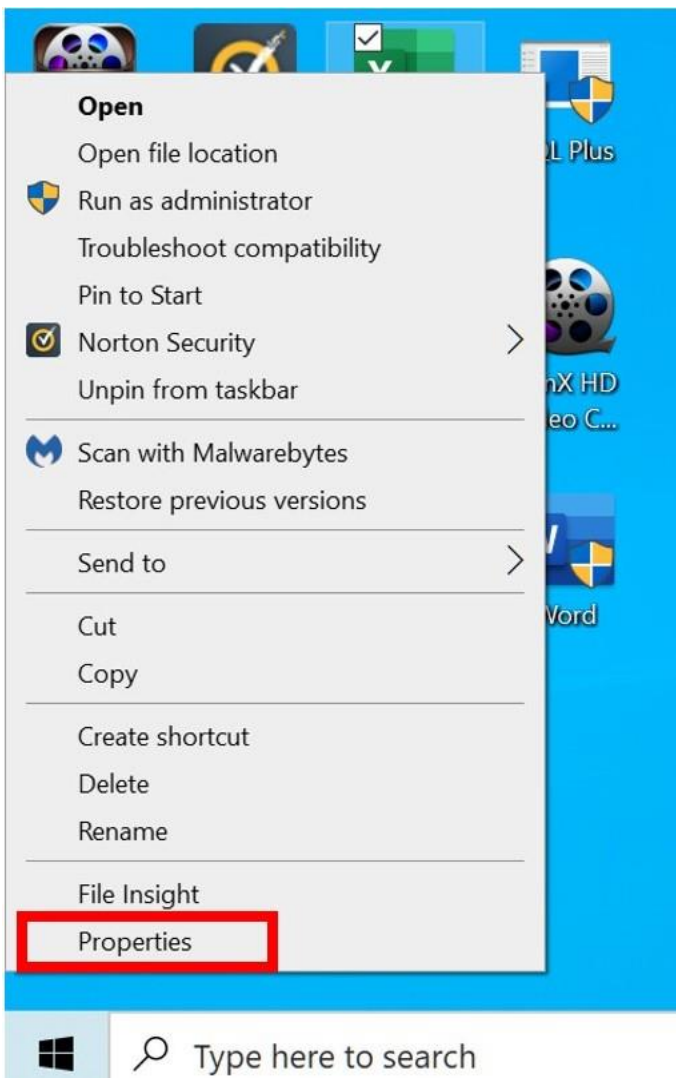


SOLUTION: For me, simply running in Administrator mode eliminated the Memory warning message. The next steps show how to set Quickbooks so it always runs using Administrator mode.

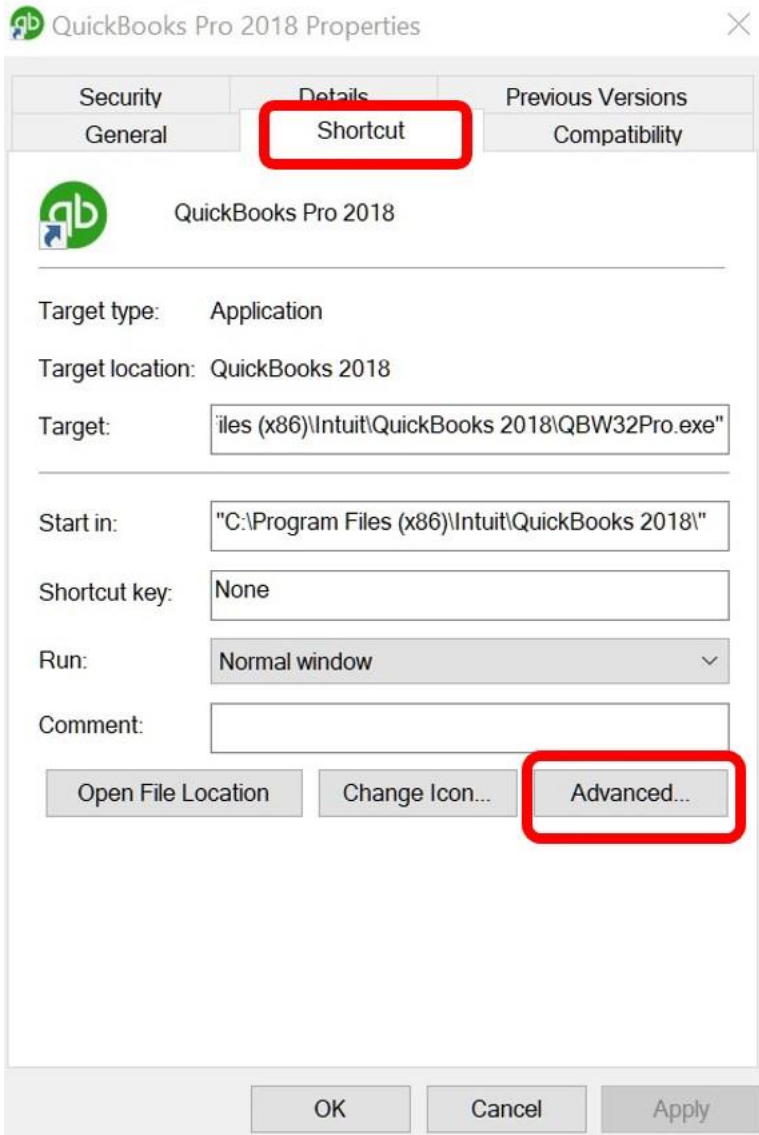
1. **RIGHT** click on the Quickbooks Desktop icon.



2. Click on "Properties". Properties is the last item in the list:



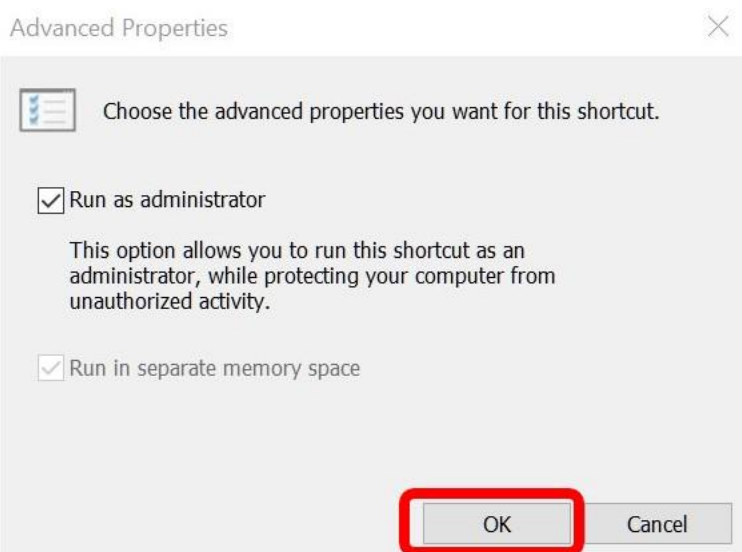
3. Click on the "Shortcut" tab.
4. Click on the "Advanced" tab.



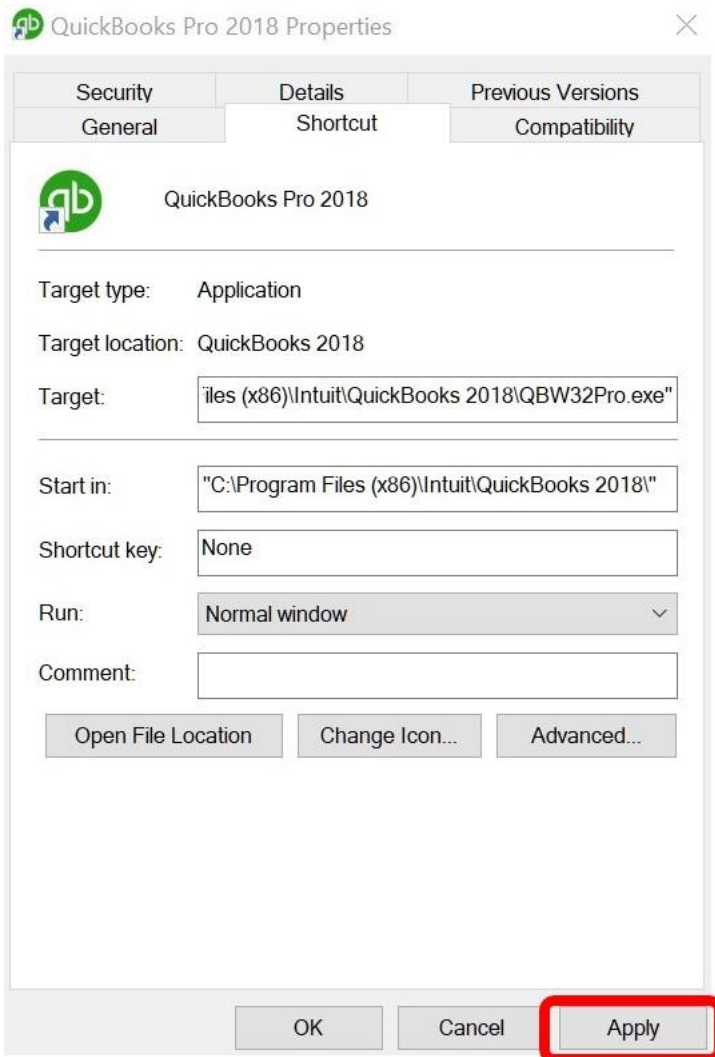
5. Check the box that says: "Run as Administrator"



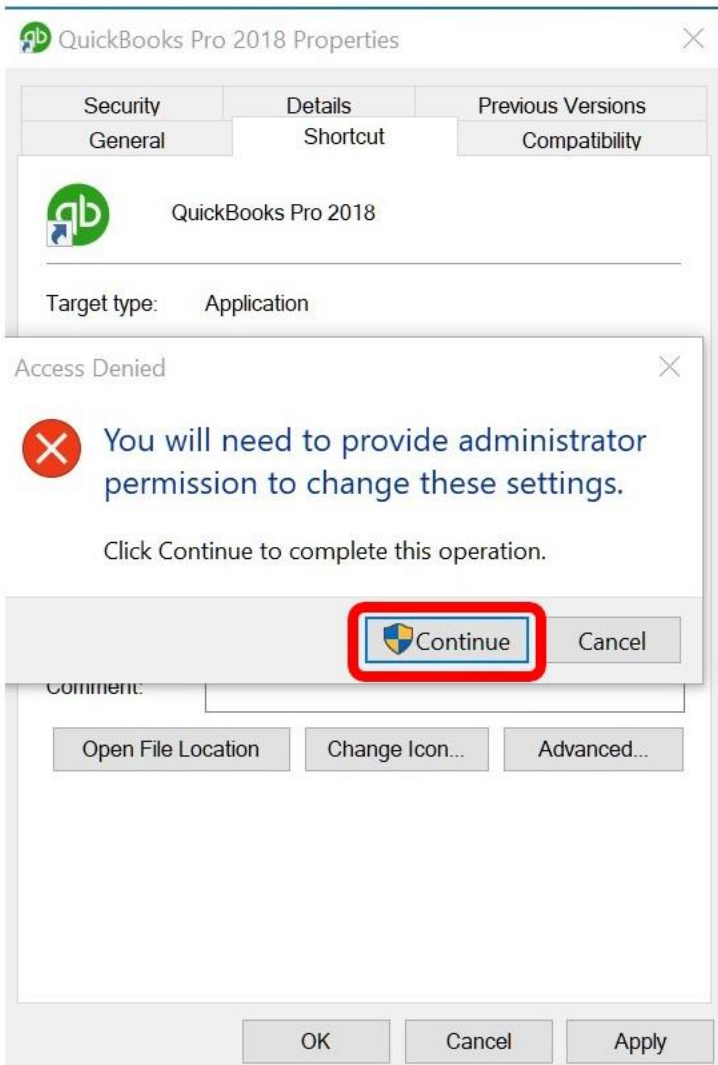
6. Click on "OK"



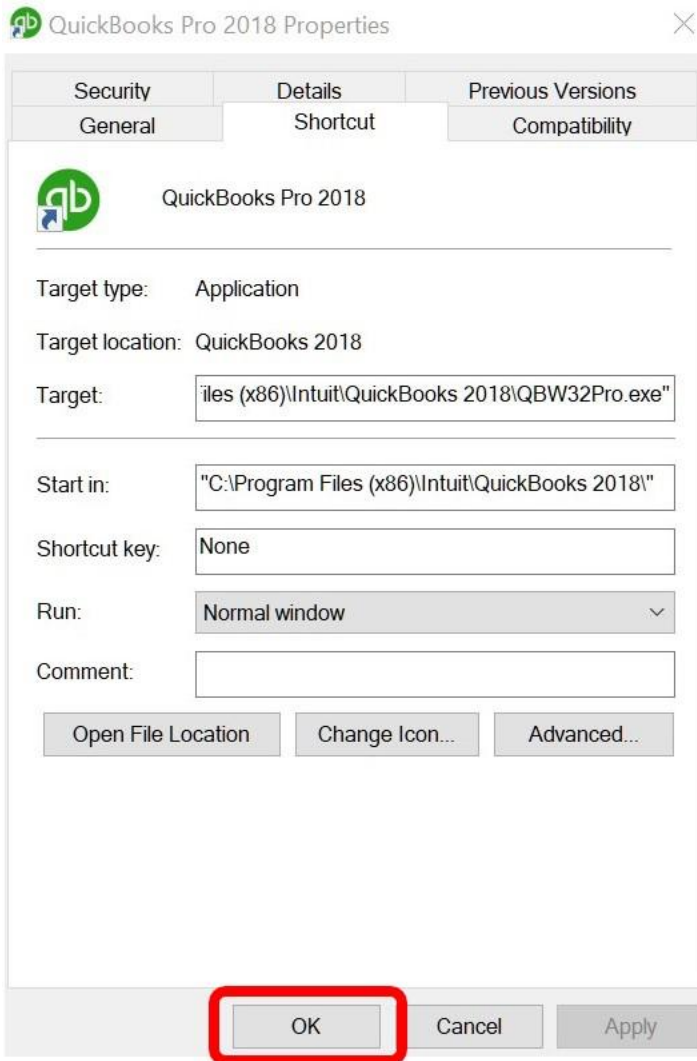
7. Click on "Apply"



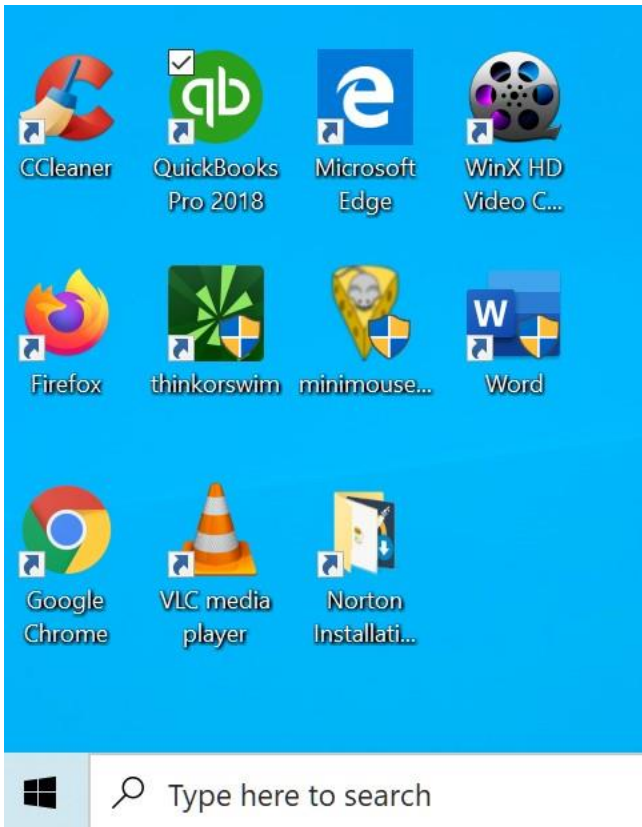
8. A message may pop up. Click on "Continue".



9. Click on "OK"



From now on, Whenever **LEFT** clicking on the Quickbooks Desktop icon, it will run in Administrator mode.
