
**PROBLEM:** Getting this message when trying to export a report to Excel:


"Your system might not have enough memory to use Excel."

#### **EXAMPLE:**


- 1. Click on Excel

4. Quickbooks will, however, still allow a csv export:




**SOLUTION:** For me, simply running in Administrator mode eliminated the Memory warning message. The next steps show how to set Quickbooks so it always runs using Administrator mode.


1. **RIGHT** click on the Quickbooks Desktop icon.




2. Click on "Properties". Properties is the last Item in the list:




- 3. Click on the "Shortcut" tab.
- 4. Click on the "Advanced" tab.




## 5. Check the box that says: "Run as Administrator"




### 6. Click on "OK"




# 7. Click on "Apply"




## 8. A message may pop up. Click on "Continue".
